Special Recycling Programs

Motor oil poured into storm drains, or tossed into trash cans (even in a sealed container) can contaminate and pollute the soil, groundwater, streams, and rivers (and it's illegal!). You can call Republic Services at (925) 685-4711 to request a used oil collection container. Then simply place your full container and oil filters next to your carts on your collection day.

Medical injection devices (sharps) require special handling and disposal. RecycleSmart and Republic Services have teamed up to make proper disposal of these items more convenient. For disposal instructions and drop-off locations, visit: **recyclesmart.org/sharps**.

Don't toss your old or unused medications in the toilet or trash. Instead, place your prescriptions and over-the-counter medicines into a sealed plastic bag and take them to your local police or sheriff's station. RecycleSmart is

partnering with Central Contra Costa Sanitary District to provide convenient drop- off locations. Visit: recyclesmart.org/medication.



Household Hazardous Waste



Got paint, pesticides, or other toxic products to get rid of? You can take them to the Central Contra Costa Sanitary District's Household Hazardous Waste Recycling Facility at

Organics Programs

Home composting is an inexpensive and natural process that transforms your yard trimmings and food scraps into a soil amendment for your garden. RecycleSmart offers home composting workshops, discounts



on composting bins and a monthly savings on your garbage bill. For more information go to: **recyclesmart.org/composting**.

Food scraps and soiled paper items can go into your green organics cart. A food scrap container is also available at no charge. You can use this pail to collect your scraps and dump them in your organics cart. Call Republic Services at (925) 685-4711 to request a pail.

Reuse and Cleanup Days Program


